

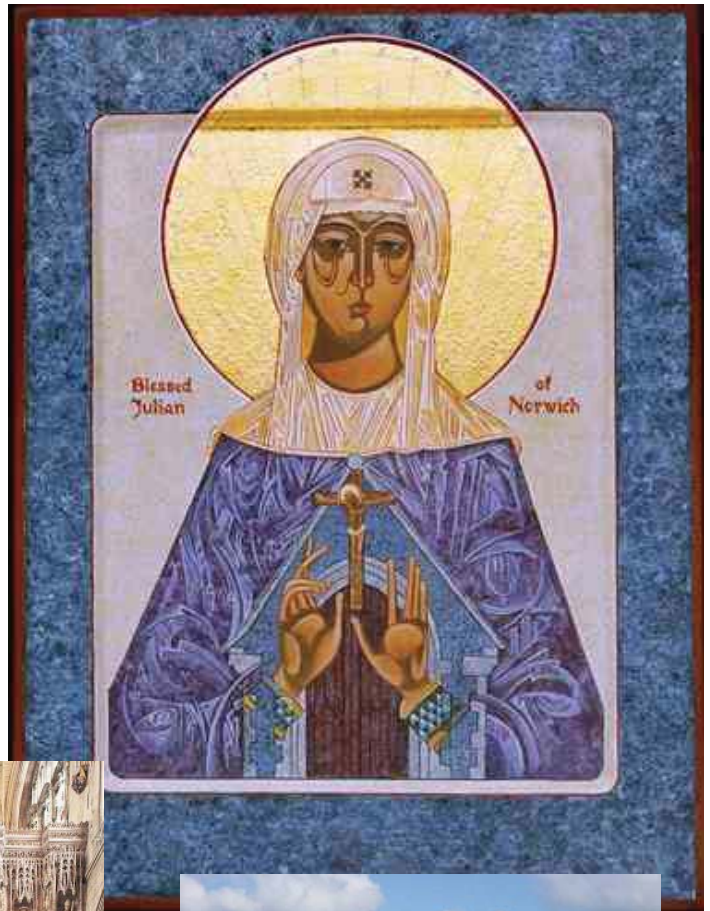
A Pilgrimage to England with The Order of Julian of Norwich

Pilgrimage is an outward expression of an inward voyage of the spirit. Daily prayer and reflection will thus form the basis of our journey to shrines, cathedrals and monastic sites, both ancient and modern. England is unique in that many of the cathedrals began as monastic foundations, so we will have the opportunity to visit some of England's finest cathedrals, as well as the ruins of medieval abbeys and priories. Most significantly, we will have the opportunity to visit the shrine of our Blessed Patron Mother Julian in Norwich. All of these sacred places will tell their stories; yet because pilgrimage is not simply a tour of historical places, we will also have the opportunity to encounter this journey with one another and in prayer 'in the spirit of Blessed Mother Julian.'

Our pilgrimage follows a tradition of generations of Christian pilgrims who have traveled to sacred places in prayer and reflection to deepen their own spirituality. In the prayerful spirit of the Order of Julian of Norwich, we will have Eucharist and daily offices each day. Depending on schedules, we may take advantage of prayer in the sacred places or conduct our own worship. Each day will have time for discussion and quiet reflection.

**Monday, September 14 –
Thursday, September 17:**

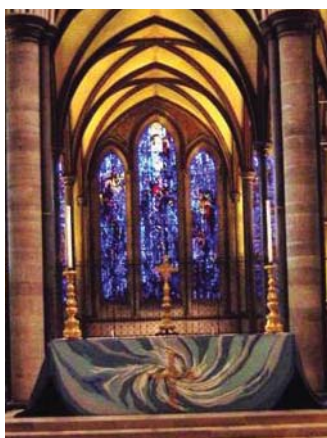
Salisbury



Pilgrims should plan to arrive in Salisbury by 3PM. Our base for three nights will be Sarum College, located within the Cathedral close. Sarum College provides refurbished meeting rooms and bedrooms offering uninterrupted views of Salisbury's stunning cathedral.

While in Salisbury, we will visit Salisbury Cathedral, which was completed as a single construction project in 1258 and boasts the tallest spire in England. We will also visit the town's museum and have leisure time.

Local tours will also include Winchester Cathedral, which dates to the 7th century and has one of the most ornate and beautiful great altar screens in all of England; as well as ancient sacred places, such as Old Sarum, the original site of Salisbury Cathedral; and Stonehenge, the prehistoric and mysterious monument.



**Thursday, September 17 –
Sunday, September 20:**

Canterbury



Following breakfast, we travel to Canterbury. Our base for three nights will be at the Cathedral Lodge, a three-star hotel located within the walled and secluded grounds of the Cathedral. Each room has a superb view of the Cathedral, the mother church of England and the Anglican Communion. Canterbury is where St. Augustine brought the Christian message and the monastic rule to England.

While in Canterbury, we will have a tour of the Cathedral and a Candlelit pilgrimage. We will visit St. Augustine's



Abbey and the burial place of St. Augustine. We will also visit St. Martin's Church which predates Augustine's arrival and within whose walls people have worshiped for over 1,400 years.

**Sunday, September 20 –
Wednesday, September 23:**

Norwich

Following breakfast and Sunday Eucharist at the Cathedral, our coach will transfer us to Norwich where we will have the remainder of the day at leisure. Our accommodations will be at Maids Head Hotel, a three-star hotel adjacent to the Norman Cathedral. In Norwich, we will have the opportunity to visit the Cathedral which has the largest cloister in England as well as a labyrinth.



We will also have a day trip to the Shrine of Our Lady at Walsingham, a traditional and sacred space for pilgrims. The highlight of our pilgrimage will be a visit to Julian's Shrine, where we will have time for prayer and reflection and a private Eucharist in Julian's Cell.

**Wednesday, September 23 –
Friday, September 25:**

London



We will travel by coach to London, where our accommodations will be at the Lancaster Hall Hotel, conveniently located near Hyde Park and Kensington Gardens. We conclude our pilgrimage with a panoramic tour of London, including the London Eye, tours of St. Paul's and Westminster Abbey where we will enjoy choral evensong. Before we end our tour, we will enjoy a farewell dinner together.

Friday, September 25: Depart London

After breakfast at the hotel, arrangements are on your own for departure from London.

Gwynne has been a long time Anglophile, visiting many sacred places in England when she visits her step-children and grandchildren in England. Mthr. Please read all Tour Features and Conditions carefully. Payment of tour deposit constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Air Transportation is not included in the tour price.

Accommodations: Based on two persons sharing a room in accommodations listed in itinerary, or similar, with private facilities, including service charges and taxes. Single rooms are subject to availability at an additional charge of \$450. *If a passenger cannot supply a roommate, the passenger is responsible for the additional charge.*

Meals: Breakfast is included daily, as well as two lunches and eight dinners. Opportunity will be given for meals that are not included to be secured by tour members, at their own expense. Beverages with meals are not included.

Transfers and Baggage: *Pilgrims are responsible to find their own transportation to Sarum College, Salisbury, by 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 17. Arrangements end with breakfast at Lancaster Hall Hotel, Friday, September 25. Due to limited storage space on motor coaches, each tour participant is asked to limit his or her luggage to one medium-sized suitcase per person, plus a flight bag/carry-on, to be handled by the tour participant.*

Sightseeing and Entrance Fees: Are included as indicated in itinerary, using private motorcoach or other conveyance, with local guides where necessary.

Tips and Taxes: Service charges and taxes on accommodations are included. Tips to guides, drivers, and hotel staff are included. Tips for personal services are not included and are at tour member's own expense.

Not Included: Airfare, passport fee, travel protection insurance, meals not listed on itinerary, and expenses of a purely personal nature are not included. Transportation from your home to Sarum College and from London to your home is not included.

Deposit and Payment: Reservations may be confirmed with a total deposit of \$300 per person. You will be invoiced for final payment, which is due July 15, 2009.

MTS Cancellation Conditions: Refund of full deposit (less \$50 administrative fee) will be made up to June 8, 2009. If cancellation occurs between June 9 and July 15, 2009, a fee of \$300 will be charged. From July 16, 2009, to departure, the fee is \$300 plus unrecoverable airline, hotel and tour operator payments. There is no refund for unused tour services.

Protect Your Investment: Upon receipt of your deposit, MTS Travel will send you information on purchasing travel protection, along with a tour confirmation. *If you purchase the protection plan within 21 days of the date of your confirmation, any restriction on pre-existing conditions is waived.* If protection plan is purchased after the 21 days, all coverage is subject to exclusion of pre-existing conditions. After purchasing travel protection, you will receive a detailed description of the protection plan, which you will have ten days to review. Certain conditions, exclusions and limitations apply as set out in the Evidence of Coverage and Confirmation of Coverage. Following is a brief description of travel protection coverage:

- This is primary emergency coverage.
- This protection plan will cover you for cancellation fees if you need to cancel because of death, injury or illness to you, your traveling companion or your immediate family member.
- Trip Interruption or Delay
- Medical Evacuation
- Medical Expenses
- Lost, stolen or damaged baggage

A valid passport is required. If you do not have a passport, you should apply for one immediately. Information on obtaining a passport will be provided upon receipt of deposit. If you now have a passport, please verify that it is valid until March 25, 2010. A visa for England is not required for U.S. citizens.

All rates and fares are based on current information and are subject to change. Rates are based on a minimum of 25 persons traveling together. Charges will be incurred for individual deviations or special requests apart from the group itinerary.

The itinerary as outlined is an indication of sequence and sites to be included in the tour program. However, the tour operator reserves the right to alter or change the itinerary and/or the sites included should it be deemed necessary due to local conditions, time restrictions, or other circumstances.
